Projection mapping is a technique to project video footage onto surfaces, such as buildings or other large objects, to create impressive displays.



In this immersive opportunity, Baker will take students through the process of capturing, editing and rigging for video-projected installations. Utilising smart devices and accessible software, students will create their own audiovisual works followed by an introduction to video projection mapping and VJing.
