



## Non-Local Application for Placement in Year 7 – 2022

All Year 6 students in government primary schools will be issued with a white *Expression of Interest* form for placement in Year 7 at a government high school. This form must be returned to your primary school.

Students living within Kirrawee's boundaries, as drawn by the *Department of Education*, are deemed local students (see below). Students outside the Kirrawee High boundary are classified as non-local and for enrolment applications must complete the *Non-Local Application for Placement in Year 7 – 2022* form and return it to Kirrawee High School by Friday 12 March 2021.

From Kirrawee High, the local area extends north to, but does not include either side of, President Avenue. It extends east to, but does not include, either side of Gymea Bay Road north of the right of way adjacent to house number 202. Beginning at Gymea Bay Oval, the local area extends further east to include Balla Machree Way, Carter Crescent, Matong Place and Ellesmere Road. To the west, the area extends to Acacia Road (east side only). The link below will direct you the boundary map for Kirrawee High and/or you may contact the Department of Education for related enquiries.
